

University Ordinances/ Regulations

- 1.** In order to give research opportunity to the qualified and potential teachers other, employees, researchers, administrators, scientists, technocrat's Industries-personnel, executives, NGO's and other professionals, Singhania University has introduced Part Time Ph.D. program in its different departments/ faculties/ subjects with immediate effect.
- 2.** Besides the modifications/ changes to be affected by the University, Ph.D. regulations and minimum standards and procedure for the award of Ph.D. Degree (existing rules) will be applicable to the part time Ph.D. programme also.
- 3.** Procedure of Admission will be through Entrance Exam (Existing norms for the JRF, Net passed candidates etc. will be followed)
- 4.** For part time Ph.D. requirement of experience will be as under: -
 - (a) Two years' service experience for the employees of teaching departments with P.G.
 - (b) Three years' service experience for non-teaching staff employees of private or public sector enterprises with P.G.
 - (c) There should be no break in service.
 - (d) Candidates are required to submit online applications available at our website "www.singhaniauniversity.co.in (research and publication- admission to Ph.D.)"
- 5.** The minimum duration of the part time Ph.D. will be four years starting from the date of registration, maximum will be 7 years.
- 6.** Coursework for both the categories (Regular/Part Time) will be as per existing regulations 2016: -
 - 180 hours of 1 semester course work will be completed as under:-
 - (a) Through regular teaching classes for fifteen days in the university campus from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. i.e. a minimum of 90 hours.
 - (b) Supervisor- directed course work classes will be conducted on Saturdays and Sundays for completing the rest 90 hours.
 - (c) Course work classes may be extended for another six months if a candidate is not able to complete his 180 hours in the first semester.
- 7.** After completing the course work the candidate can submit his synopsis for further process.
- 8.** Half yearly progress reports are to be submitted by the researchers for regular analysis of their research progress.
- 9.** Pre-submission presentation may be done before the concerned department.
